Student(s) selected each year to receive \$2500.00 [subject to increase]. Award intended to recognize students demonstrating unusual combinations of talent, intellectual risk taking, and exemplary use & application of college resources. These students, exhibit what has been called **the other three R's – Resiliency, Responsibility & Reasoning**. Though unlikely to receive recognition via conventional institutional criteria, these students typically reflect many of the qualities & characteristics described as essential for addressing the challenges of a highly unique future in the human story. As of 2012, there have been ten recipients.
